

Declaration of Conformity according to Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 (POP)

The Stockholm Convention (Persistent Organic Pollutants - POP) aims to protect human health and the environment with specific control measures by eliminating persistent organic pollutants. To this end, the regulation bans or restricts the production, use, import and export of POPs. At European level, Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 June 2019 on persistent organic pollutants (POP Regulation) transposes the international agreement into European law.

It is hereby declared that ROSE Systemtechnik GmbH does not produce any POPs. Furthermore, it is ensured via supplier queries to obtain information about the product-related substances used in our products.
